A coordination meeting with Saudi Arabian Chevron (SAC)



In the scope of the two sides' keenness to discuss ways of cooperation, KGOC & SAC held a coordination meeting to review the progress of work and the latest developments of existing projects in WJO.

The meeting, held at Ahmed Al-Jaber Oil and Gas Exhibition, was chaired by the DCEO of Joint Operations, Mr. Mohammad Al-Haimer, and in the presence of the Executive Management represented by the DCEO of Technical & Commercial Affairs, Mr. Mohammad Al-Zubi, and the DCEO of Finance & Administration Affairs, Mr. Nayef Al-Anezi. SAC was represented by Mr. Clay Neff, Chevron President MEA & SA, accompanied by the SAC CEO, Mr. Hakim Al-Ruwaili, DCEO of Finance & Administration Affairs, Mr. Mohammad Al-Dosari, and the DCEO of Operations Affairs, Mr. Don Stelling.

Mr. Al-Haimer emphasized that there is full agreement on long-term plans so that the partners can prepare for the needs of those plans and projects, which was also emphasized by Mr. Clay.

Mr. Al-Zubi talked about the importance of early preparation of some important and future projects, achieving the best financial return for both partners.

Moreover, Mr. Al-Anezi reviewed some successful experiences and practices that could be applied in joint operations. Mr.

Stelling stressed the need for meetings and workshops to build on the experiences of both parties.

The two sides have confirmed their constant keenness to provide the necessary resources to overcome all obstacles to achieve the objectives of cooperation in the joint area in the economic interest of the two sides, considering the utmost levels of security and safety.

In a press statement, KGOC confirmed that the meeting had reviewed the production development plan, and discussed the main future programs for short- and long-term operational plans, in addition to following-up the progress and development of work programs, placing alternative programs to overcome all challenges, and ensure the highest benefits and access to the agreed production plan in the joint area.

In its statement, the Company explained that the WJO future vision had been presented, and all possible means had been taken to achieve the agreed strategic objectives, prominent of which is reducing gas flaring to the permissible percentages, and using the latest technology in the drilling of wells to improve production and develop the area's facilities. It stressed the two sides' efforts to overcome all obstacles, and work to develop exploration and the production of non-associated gas, and heavy and light oil.
