Meeting of the Kuwaiti - Saudi Permanent Joint Committee

In the presence of its Chairman and the Head of the Kuwaiti side, Sheikh Dr. Nimr Fahad Al-Sabah, and the Head of the Saudi side, Assistant Minister of Energy Eng. Mohammed bin Abdulrahman Al-Borahim, in addition to several members from both sides, the Kuwaiti-Saudi Permanent Joint Committee met at the headquarters of Wafra Joint Operations in Kuwait.

In this regard, and according to a statement issued by the Ministry of Oil, Sheikh Al-Sabah stated that this meeting came to follow up and assess business in WJO & KJO. The Committee emphasized implementing the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding signed



between the State of Kuwait and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in 2019 and overcoming any challenges facing petroleum projects.

He added that the Committee had reviewed the perception study of the road and the passage for Joint Operations through the Nuwaiseeb and Khafji ports and their engineering schemes. Furthermore, it considered the Joint Operations' future vision and plans, modernizing work mechanisms and facilitating work, and the safety of staff in operating companies, i.e., Aramco, SAC, and KGOC, to ensure meeting any emergency or exceptional situations.
