Completing the Phase II The Khafji New Gas Transit pipeline 12"

The Khafji New Gas Transit Line Project to deliver the State of Kuwait's share from KJO to the country's local facilities is one of the projects that KGOC is proud to accomplish, as it serves the Kuwaiti oil sector's strategic directions aimed at enhancing the local capabilities of gas supplies and optimizing the utilization of the petroleum resources in the Divided Zone between the State Kuwait and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

KGOC successfully completed Phase II of the project and implemented the mechanical operation of the 12" gas pipeline linking its pipelines and the KOC's export pipeline down to the KNPC's natural gas liquefaction plant transporting Kuwait's share of light gas and condensate from KJO, which is estimated at 40 MMSCFD of gas and 6,000 BPD of LNG.

Geographically, the 12" export pipeline is routed approximately 4 KM onshore from KGOC export facilities to a block valve station nearshore at Khafji and then routed through 47 KM offshore and landing on the shore of Al-Zour, Kuwait. Then, it travels through a designated KOC pipeline approximately 58 KM onshore Kuwait and will be tie-in to existing and new KOC 24" Sour gas pipelines to the downstream and upstream of KOC Intermediate slug catcher, travelling to KNPC MAA Refinery Slug Catcher.

In addition to the economic feasibility, it has




a positive impact on the local environment by contributing to further reducing gas flaring rates, recovering the burned gas, and enhancing the State of Kuwait's position among the leading countries in terms of environment.

Several entities have coordinated and cooperated to implement this project internally with KPC and other associate companies, including KOC, KNPC and KIPIC. In addition to other coordination at broader levels, including the Kuwaiti government represented by the Ministry of Oil and several other relevant ministries, Aramco Gulf Operation Company, and KJO.



WJO Gas Mitigation Project A New Success in WJO

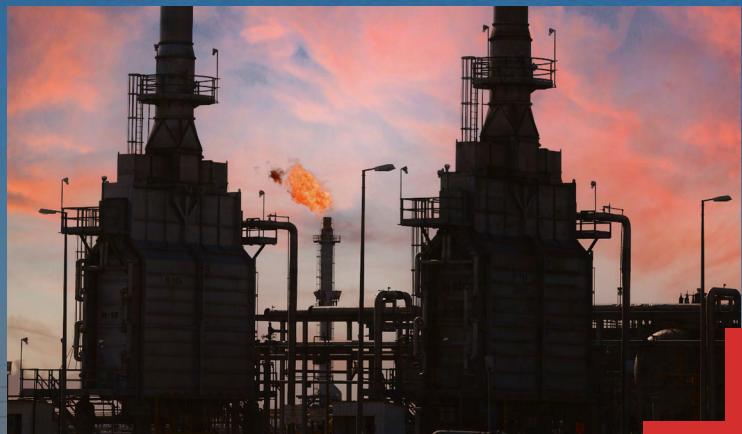


WJO Gas Mitigation Project is one of the major projects implemented by KGOC this year, targeting both environmental and production aspects at the same time. It is part of the Short-Term Operating Plan of the Memorandum of Understanding signed between KGOC, KOC, and SAC to export WJO's surplus produced gas and reduce gas flaring in WJO according to a short and long-term operating plan.

The primary objective of the project is to reduce gas flaring in WJO to meet the KEPA Gas Flaring Law, which stipulates that the "Permissible proportion of natural or associated gas to be burnt should not exceed 5% of the total daily production".

The project scope includes construction of compressors plant, and operation and maintenance of several compressor plants located at common compressors stations and SUG. In addition to construction of new compressors to compress WJO Gas to KOC through 18" Pipeline to reduce gas flaring in WJO. Furthermore, installing booster facilities with a capacity of 31 MMSCFD which can be increased, installing integrated control and safety system to detect any gas leaks or fires, and handling the gas and condensate liquid by close drain system.

This project was a result of the constant cooperation and fruitful efforts of the partners in WJO, i.e., SAC, and the efforts of WJO staff and the project team, which completed it in record time.



Discussed the Performance Indicators & Capital Projects The Biannual Meeting of the Executive Management

The KGOC Executive Management, headed by the Acting CEO Mr. Khalid Abdullah Al-Otaibi, and in the presence of the DCEO of Finance & Administration Affairs, Mr. Nayef Al-Anezi, and the managers of the Head Office's groups, held its biannual meeting with WJO. It took place on Thursday, December 22, 2022, at the Ahmad Al-Jaber Oil & Gas Exhibition -Ahmadi. The meeting, which was organized by the Corporate Planning Group, discussed current and future work plans, in addition to several technical issues, including the challenges facing the Company, performance indicators and existing capital projects.

It was held on Sunday, December 11, 2022, at the Ahmad Al-Jaber Oil & Gas Exhibition.

During the meeting, Mrs. Al-Husseini spoke about many topics, clarifying the rights of persons with



disabilities, including the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Law No. 8 of 2010, the International Convention ratified by the State of Kuwait in 2013, and the meaning of disability as a part of human diversity. Mrs. Al-Husseini was honored by Mr. Materan Al-Shammari, Team Leader of the PR & I Team, and Mrs. Afrah Al-Adwani, Chief Media Relations Officer, presenter of the lecture.

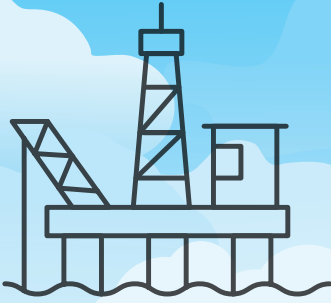
