## Operating the Joint Operations route at the Nuwaiseeb Port

## The SLB Digital Drill Log Project: The First in the Region



To celebrate the success of WJO Digitization and the SLB Digital Drill Log Project, the first in the Middle East, Schlumberger (SLB) International, in collaboration with KGOC and its partner in WJO, SAC, organised the "Digitalization in WJO" Workshop. It took place on Wednesday, May 15, 2024, at the Grand Hyatt 360.

The project aims at fully digital follow-up and control of all assets, operations of drilling, construction, and production, and equipment through a unified digital platform that provides detailed data and reports updated electronically.

The workshop reviewed the project's action plan, which began in 2022 and achieved a paradigm shift in providing data and monitoring operations remotely. Moreover, it explained the future of digitalization in this project and the further data it will provide.

## Full Pilot Operation of the Steam Generator



In a move to achieve operational and productive excellence in the WJO Area, the Steam Flood Project Team, one of the major projects aimed at improving heavy oil production in the 1<sup>st</sup> Eocene Reservoir, successfully achieved the full pilot operation of the steam generator at the Steam Flood Plant on Tuesday, May 28, 2024.

This achievement is a significant and critical step in the Steam Flood Project phases, particularly the next phase of the project, which has a major positive impact on the management of WJO. The project focuses on using its available equipment in a periodic way to improve the production of certain wells and to emphasise the readiness of facilities and equipment such as the Water Treatment Unit, Evaporation Unit, and Steam Generators.

The Team Leader of the Steam Flood Project Operations, Eng. Ahmad Hassan, commended the efforts of the team members Senior Plant Maintenance Engineer,



Nawaf Al Harbi, Operations Engineer, Anfal Qurban, and Senior Thermal Production Engineer, Ahmed Al-Mulla, in addition to SAC's experts, for their effective contributions to the successful fulfilment of this achievement and their keenness to consider security and safety procedures in all stages of the project.
