from both teams, to explain the tasks and responsibilities of their teams, the main projects they manage, and the authorities they cooperate with in this regard.

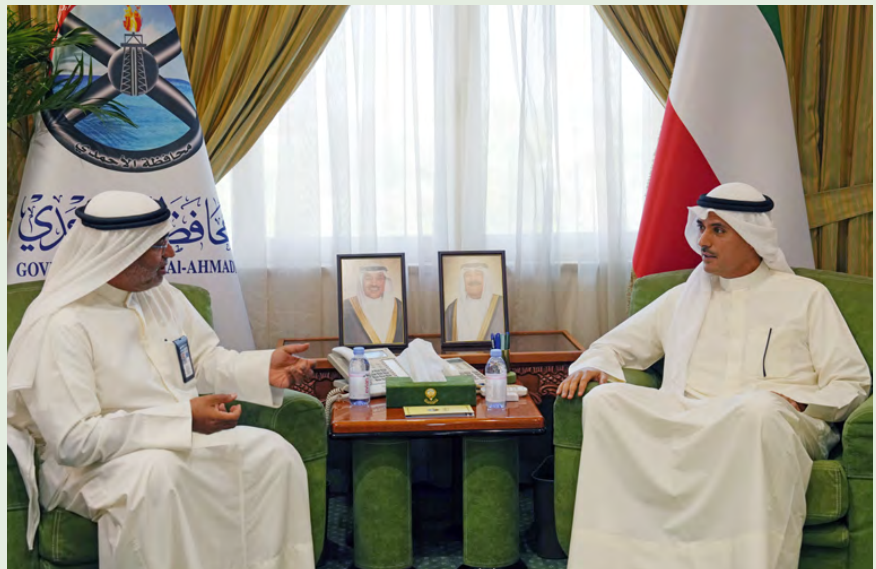

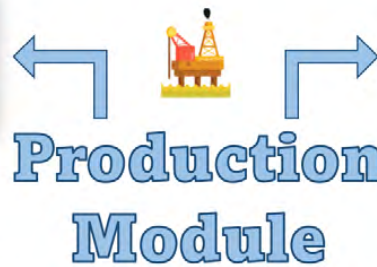

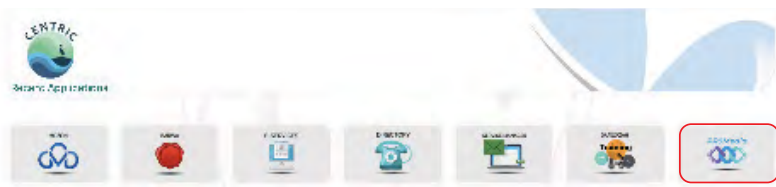
