National Day Celebrations at the Nuwaiseeb Land Port

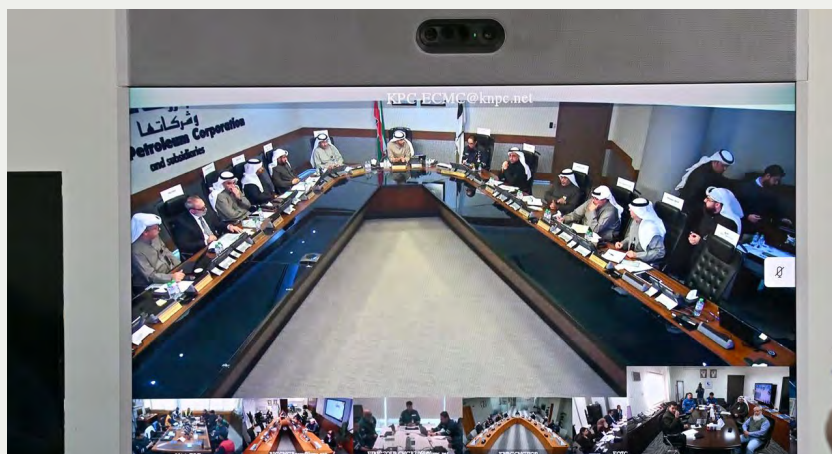


Annual Unified Field Exercise for Crisis Management

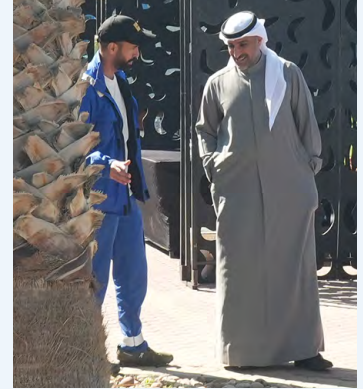
Forum for Employees in WJO
